Message from Congress president



Dear colleagues and friends !

It is a great honour for me to cordially welcome you to the 7th Central European Vascular Forum Congress held this year in Timisoara, a wonderful city settled on the banks of Bega river and the largest city in western Romania.

The first record of the city of Timisoara, built on the site of an ancient Roman fortress called Castrum Regium Themes, dates back to 1212. Over the years, our city has been influenced by many cultures. The Romans used it as an important crossroads fortress until the Tatars destroyed it in the 13th century.

Conquered by Turkish armies in 1552, Timisoara remained under their protection until 1718 when the region of Banat came under Austrian rule for two centuries. Later, Timisoara became a very important medieval commercial and manufacturing town. Turks, Austrians, Hungarians, Germans and Serbs all left their mark and their influence can be seen in neighborhoods throughout the city even today. The charm of this city lies in its distinct architectural character and vibrant cultural life.

Frequently referred to as "Little Vienna", Timisoara is home to year-round musical and theatrical performances, art galleries, museums and a buzzing nightlife.

A progressive, cosmopolitan place, Timisoara was the first European city to introduce horse-drawn trams (in 1869) and electrical street lighting (in 1884). The first elementary school from Romania was opened in 1718 in Timisoara and in the same year, the oldest Brewery in the country was documented.

The building at the first city hospital from Romania began here in 1745. After years, Timisoara became in 1953 the only European city which had three state theatre in Romanian, Ungarian and German language. The Olympic swimming champion and movies star Johnny Weissmuller, Hollywood's original Tarzan, was born here.

This was the place where the anticomunist revolution started in December 1989.

Timisoara abounds with churches of several denominations, an elegant baroque square and a pedestrian-only downtown area. Some of the monuments in the heart of the city afford panoramic views, while the many parks in this "city of flowers" provide an idyllic spot to take a break from sightseeing. Timisoara is very nice in the month of may.

Dear colleagues, dear friends, beside the scientific part of this meeting I would like to invite you to get to know our city, its past and present.

May you have a fruit full conference and a wonderful stay in this magnificent city.

CEVF PRIZE

The Central European Vascular Forum and the Congress Organization will provide prizes for the best oral presentation for young angiologists (age less than 40 years). Prizes will be awarded to the three best oral presentation according to their originality and standard of presentation. The full papers will be considered for publication in International Angiology, the official journal of the International Union of Angiology and Central European Vascular Forum after peer review. To qualify for the CEVF Prize the full manuscript of the paper must be handed to the Chairmen of the CEVF Prize Session.
